Obedience & Rally Move-Ups

Versatility

After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level of class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.

Move-up forms may be downloaded from the AKC website (www.akc.org) and/or will also be available at the trial secretary's table.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES <u>CANNOT</u> BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- ENTRIES WITHOUT FEES will <u>NOT</u> be accepted. Make all checks payable to the GREEN BAY SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB, INC. Please do not send cash. There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks.

- NO REFUNDS FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been
 processed, no refund will be made.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for all errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published date of closing.
- FEES include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee & the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes. (No fee collected for sweenstakes or brace).

 Sweepstakes, and any Sweepstakes entry fee submitted for such dog shall be refunded upon request of the dog's owner or agent, if
 such request is received by the Show Secretary no later than the closing date of the Show. For the purpose of those rules, the date of
 record for the Championship shall be the date of the show at which the dog won its final points.
- All Sweepstakes entries MUST also be entered in a regular class. "Sweepstakes" must be indicated on the entry form under "Additional Classes".
- Should it be found that an ineligible dog has received an award in the Sweepstakes, the person to whom such award was presented
 shall make restitution to the GBSSC and such award shall be deemed to have been won by the dog judged second to the dog
 declared ineligible. The prize money and other awards shall then be redistributed to conform to the rules regarding the Division of
 Prize Money.
- Classes will be as follows: DIVIDED BY SEX
 - Puppies, 6 months and under 9 months & 9 months and under 12 months
 - Juniors, 12 months and under 18 months
- BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES competition will be held for the winners of the sweepstakes classes. After selection of Best in Sweepstakes, the Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes shall be selected from the remaining class winners. The Runner Up will receive no additional prize money, but will be awarded a rosette.

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY

Instructions

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety your are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog; i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
